### Telegraph Hill Lower Park

- 1) Who designed the park and in what year was it officially opened?
- 2) By the water's edge are two large trees with branches hanging down and nearly touching the ground. What are they?
- 3) By a playhouse, stands a dead tree with a wildlife home attached. Who lives there?
- 4) Keep following the path. The second tree along the Arbuthnot Road fence has some holes towards the top. What animal would have made those?
- 5) Further along this fence, past the fallen log, is a herb bush. What type is it?
- 6) Head up the hill and you'll come to a crossroad with a large tree in the middle. What sort of tree is it?
- 7) As you keep following the path towards the basketball court, just past the entrance to the skatepark, there are some bushes/trees on the right that have spiky leaves. What are they?
- 8) Past the skatepark, and over the low fence, there's a beech tree on the grass. At its base are mast (a type of nut) shells. Collect one

- 14) How many big steps are there from the log to the picnic table?
